When you make a wrong choice, someone else besides yourself almost always has to pay for the consequences of your actions. It could be the victim or intended victim of your crime, it could be your parents, police, school personnel, courts, friends, etc. All of your actions have reactions that cause work and time for other people. This sheet will help you to calculate who else has paid for your actions. On the far left are the people involved with your offense, followed by the time/fees/the amount of time they spent doing each of those things, and their rate or pay. You will need to calculate the time/hours involved for each person then multiply the rows straight across according to their rate/pay. After that, you will need to add all the rows all together for a grand total of how much this incident has cost. This will then give you an estimate of the cost your offense has had overall and how others were involved and affected.
